### About the Environmental Championship Program (Abtal el Bi'a)

The Environmental Championship Program (ECP) is a new innovative environmental education program for kids, and is the fruit of a collaboration between the [LMTA](#) and [EcoConsulting](#).

The ECP consists in organizing 5-day environmental awareness and sustainable living programs, engaging children from diverse ethnic, religious, and social backgrounds in joint social-environmental action. It is built on the concept of experiential learning, with hands-on, fun, and creative activities aiming to give kids a clear understanding of the full loop that is our supporting ecosystem. Our objective is to empower those kids by giving them the title of “Environmental

Champions” and inspiring them to become stewards of our planet in a proactive way: protecting nature, acting sensibly about eco-issues, communicating around them important environmental messages.

So far, we have undertaken 25 ECPs since April 2015 with **405 kids** between 9 and 15 years old, from public and private schools, becoming Environmental Champions.

## About us

### ABOUT THE LMTA

Established in 2007, the Lebanon Mountain Trail Association (LMTA) is striving to develop and protect the first long distance hiking trail in the country: The Lebanon Mountain Trail (LMT). The LMT is a 470 km path crossing 75 towns and villages from Andqet in the north, to Marjaayoun in the south, at altitudes ranging from 600 to 2,000 meters above sea level, in addition to one Heritage Site, two Biosphere Reserves, and four Protected Areas. The LMTA works tirelessly to develop, protect, and promote the LMT as a world class eco-tourism and hiking destination, and is a founding member of the World Trail Network and a member of the Mountain Partnership. The LMT today attracts more than 25,000 visitors annually and represents a unique national corridor for rural tourism & natural conservation.



### OUR PURPOSE

- To maintain, protect and develop the LMT and its side trails
- To promote the LMT as a destination for rural tourism and wellness
- To conserve natural resources and protect historical landmarks on the LMT
- To advance economic opportunities on the LMT through responsible tourism
- To encourage behavior, change through targeted education and outreach

**OUR ACTIVITIES** are diverse and are geared in this direction:

- Each year the LMTA organizes its 30-day Thru-Hike in April and its 15-day Fall Trek, where hundreds of hikers & outdoor lovers from over a dozen countries join a core team of trekkers to walk the trail.
- We work with schools and educators on extracurricular activities to sensitize and educate children and youth on the LMT and the environmental and cultural wealth along it.
- We work on trails corridor planning, clearing & blazing, and setting up Friendship Trails with international trail organizations.
- We train local guides, and we help refurbish and equip local guesthouses and support local people to improve their hospitality, thus improving the income of rural communities along the trail
- We work to rehabilitate heritage and cultural sites.

## THE ENVIRONMENTAL CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAM (ECP)



In 2015, we have introduced under the LMT Education Committee & in collaboration with EcoConsulting, a new innovative environmental education program for kids, entitled **Environmental Championship Program (ECP)**.

### Needs/Problems/Rational

The state of the environment in Lebanon is presently near-disastrous, with endless littering, pollution, traffic, over-consumption, waste, etc... and our mountains, sea, and nature are being damaged at an alarming rate, causing us to suffer from collective problems such as pollution-related health issues. Unfortunately, due to the lack of proper environmental awareness, environmental issues are not considered a priority in the country and most people do not make any effort to change some simple habits that can collectively make a huge difference. Although the current schools' curriculum incorporates some elements on the environment, it is not deemed sufficient and does not seem to offer an integrated approach to understanding our ecosystem's living cycle. Indeed, environmental topics are currently addressed in most schools as "activities" or disconnected topics (such as energy, water, recycling, etc.) that are taught separately but they should rather become part of our way of living, and teachers should be catalysts to change non-ecofriendly habits.

We believe that once a kid has a clear understanding of all the elements that constitute natural resources, our living cycle, and the current state of the planet, he/she would be more inclined to contribute to bettering things around him/her. This is why we have decided to launch a new innovative **Environmental Championship Program (ECP)**, which aim will be to tackle environmental education for kids from public and private schools, following an integrative holistic approach.

The ECP project consists in organizing 5-day environmental awareness and sustainable living education programs, engaging selected children from diverse ethnic, religious, and social backgrounds in joint social-environmental action. The programs will be built on the concept of experiential learning, with hands-on, fun, and creative activities aiming to give kids a clear understanding of the full loop that is our supporting ecosystem; that everything is linked and each of our actions impact nature and ultimately us directly or indirectly.

### Goals/Objectives

The ECP will provide intensive hands-on environmental education programs (5 days each) to small groups of selected kids (age between 9 & 12) from different public & private schools in Lebanon. The idea behind the ECP is for the kids to become passionate about the environment, to develop an emotional connection, a sense of belonging and responsibility towards one's community and surrounding environment, therefore transmitting their new awareness about sustainability.

The ECP will aim to empower selected kids by giving them the title of 'Environmental Champions', and inspiring them to become stewards of our planet and lead environmental change in a pro-active way: protecting nature, acting sensibly about eco-issues, communicating around them the important environmental messages. Following the 5-day program, each one of them would engage in their own small eco-project throughout the following year, at school or in their community, with the help of a mentor assigned to each kid.

#### The main objectives to attain with the ECP are:

1) Instill in the kids a real sense of environmental awareness: At the end of the ECP it should become clear to them how everything around us is interlinked, everything we use/consume/eat comes from the Earth and comes back in a way or another to it, and that we all have directly or indirectly an impact on us, our health, and our community.

2) Empower kids to become stewards of the environment. Through the mentorship, the project will help developing eco-leadership skills, getting the kids to launch and grow new eco-initiatives, while influencing their parents and little surrounding.

3) Indirectly, the ECP program would promote tolerance & civic education since the selected group will be heterogeneous with kids from different social backgrounds and ethnic groups.

## ECP Program

The following is a sample agenda for the 5-day Environmental Championship Program, which is broken down to cover in depth at least each of the key environmental topics & activities, in an interactive, hands-on manner. It is to be noted that each program is further adapted depending on the selected location, along the Lebanon Mountain Trail, to also introduce kids to any important landscape, geological, cultural, or archeological features of importance in the area. Additional nature-oriented activities such as caving, climbing, pottery, or nature dyes may be added to each program.

### **Day 1 Themes – Nature, Forests, Biodiversity, Trails, Responsible Hunting, and more:**

Why are the kids enrolled in ECP; Team building & trusting activities; Hike on the LMT; Nature observation & outdoor activities; Planting seeds; Responsible hunting & the principles of respecting a natural life-cycle & reproduction cycle Movies/animations about the ecosystem

**Day 2 Themes – Water & Water Pollution due to Waste, Littering, and other:** Walking along an LMT spring/water source; Water Games involving understanding water scarcity and water pollution; Visible and invisible water pollution; Activities to conserve water

**Day 3 Themes – Littering, Waste, Recycling & Upcycling:** Littering & its consequences; Understanding the principles of waste; Play about Waste & Recycling; The 3Rs; How to compost; Games about Recycling; Modules on upcycling - creating new things from old items

**Day 4 Themes – Food, Agriculture, Food Waste & Compost:** Visit of an agricultural plot; Where does our food come from; The lifecycle of a Manoushe; Veggie organic garden & cooking all together; How to reduce Food Waste; How to compost; Visit of a Landfill (if nearby)

**Day 5 Themes - Eco-Friendly House, Energy & Natural Resources, Climate Change:** Visit of an eco-friendly house; Why is most energy very polluting; Direct vs. indirect pollution & consequences; Hands-on understanding on reducing energy consumption at home/school; Healthy materials & limiting chemical usage; Climate Change

- Most of the program occurs along the LMT, with the kids sleeping in guesthouses of the LMT near the trail, experiencing the local hospitality & food; the importance of our customs & traditions; and the principles of a community.
- Environmental educators and specialists in some of the above topics will be involved to give and animate specific modules (such as the modules on upcycling, planting, agriculture, or cooking).
- LMT staff - namely the Education and Field officers - will be responsible for the outdoor activities along the trail, and administrative coordination for accommodation.
- Local guides are hired to accompany and introduce the kids to hiking & the importance of trails.
- EcoConsulting environmental experts have designed the initial ECP program content and eco-activities.
- Mentors with environmental expertise may be selected to assist during or after the ECP.



### Innovation

We believe the project is unique in Lebanon in its approach to environmental education, due to the fact that chosen kids will follow a fast-track program aiming at giving them—in a creative, hands-on, fun, & interactive way—a real understanding of our ecosystem & the closed-loop system we live in.

Typically, school activities run with large groups of kids on sporadic days / events during the year; what we would like to do in our ECP is to favor within a short time-frame a real “immersion” into the environmental world to grasp how everything around us is interlinked, everything we use/consume/eat comes from the Earth & comes back in a way or another to it, and that we all have directly or indirectly an impact on us, our health, and our community.

Giving kids the “Environmental Championship” title should help them feel proud about having been selected & eager to engage in other eco-initiatives afterwards, ideally becoming mini-eco-leaders, while influencing their parents and their little surrounding. In the long run, our hope is that all those Environmental Champions could meet together during other LMT events and a network of fellow kids would grow & collectively start making a difference.

## Budget

The budget for kid is **\$100/day** all inclusive, thus **\$500** for the 5-day camp, assuming participation of **15 kids**.

Kids are as much as possible selected from different social, cultural, ethnical, and religious backgrounds across Lebanon.
